APPLICATION AND USE

Preparation	Rinse with fresh water and allow to dry.
Method	Choose appropriate mixing ratio. Add the required number of capfuls of Super Cleaner to fresh water. Apply Super Cleaner to a damp cloth or sponge, then wipe the whole surface to be cleaned using moderate pressure. Rinse with fresh water.
Hints	Mixing - Shake well before use.
Some Important Points	Product temperature should be minimum 5°C/41°F and maximum 35°C/95°F. Ambient temperature should be minimum 5°C/41°F and maximum 35°C/95°F. Substrate temperature should be minimum 5°C/41°F and maximum 35°C/95°F.
Compatibility/Substrates	Suitable for use on GRP, painted and metal surfaces.
Application Methods	Brush/Cloth/Sponge.

TRANSPORTATION, STORAGE AND SAFETY INFORMATION

Storage	GENERAL INFORMATION: Exposure to air and extremes of temperature should be avoided. For the full shelf life of Super Cleaner to be realised ensure that between use the container is firmly closed and the temperature is between 5°C/41°F and 35°C/95°F. Keep out of direct sunlight. TRANSPORTATION: Super Cleaner should be kept in securely closed containers during transport and storage.
Safety	GENERAL: Read the label safety section for Health and Safety Information, also available from our Technical Help Line. DISPOSAL: Do not discard tins or pour paint into water courses, use the facilities provided. It is best to allow paints to harden before disposal.
